Conference Centre Directions

The conference is at the University of Cumbria, Fusehill Street Campus, Carlisle, CA1 2HH. Just off the M6, Carlisle has a good main line train station with frequent trains from Glasgow, Edinburgh, Newcastle, Liverpool and many more centres. Driving: From the M6 junction 43 for Carlisle (A69) head into Carlisle along Warwick Road. Turn left at the third set of traffic lights into Greystone Road then turn right into Fusehill Street. The campus is the second entrance on the right, with parking on-site.

Rail: Carlisle is on the main London to Glasgow west coast line. The Fusehill Street campus is a 15 minute walk, or a short taxi ride, from the railway station.

How to book

Bookings are only accepted through our on-line booking system. If you don't have internet access, please ask a friend who does. If you are unable to arrange internet access, please telephone 01935 826829 and a volunteer will enter your booking into the on-line system. This is a volunteer service, so it is not permanently staffed. It is requested that you only call between 11.00 and 22.00.

On booking you will be sent an email reservation and this reservation will be held for 2 weeks pending receipt of payment. See Payment Methods below. Once payment has been received you will be sent a confirmation email. You can view your **order status** via the on-line booking system. Note that booking will close at **midday on Friday 13th July** in order to give final catering and accommodation numbers to the venue and prepare delegate packs. Unbooked arrivals will only be admitted if there has been a late cancellation.

Accommodation £28 per person per night

Accommodation at the University can only be booked by those attending the conference.
